### Helpful Directions from Jim Pike:

**Black-throated Green Warbler:** Take Merrimac Dr. west from Fairview. It runs along the south side of OCC. Walk north into the center of the complex of bldgs. Look for the "ugly gray" Fine Arts bldg. & the 2 large juniper-type trees. The bird apparently favors one of these trees. **Palm Warblers 1 & 2:** #1 is at the bottom of Cliff Drive Park. #2 is at the top of Canyon Park. If heading down to the parking lot from 19th St, the bird was near the playground area after turning off Arbor Street. **Tropical Kingbird:** Take Harbor Blvd. to Fair Dr, then turn west into the entrance of large parking area of Fairview Developmental Center. Walk east across the street to the fence of the golf course. Lots of kingbirds congregate around the gate. The bird called a lot. At Mason Park, the **Gray Flycatcher** is usually around the alders and small trees at the east end of the lake. **Hammond's Flycatcher** is usually in or near the riparian strip at the west end of the lake near the playground equipment. Also seen on parking lot side of riparian strip well west of playground. **Dusky Flycatcher:** Bent Tree Park is off Lemon Heights Rd. It initially pushed out of ravine but may favor the far upper end of the park.

### Helpful Directions from Marshall Iliff:

**Common "Eurasian" Green-winged Teal** seems to be sleeping at high tide at outlet by Back Bay Drive & San Joaquin Hills Rd.
